

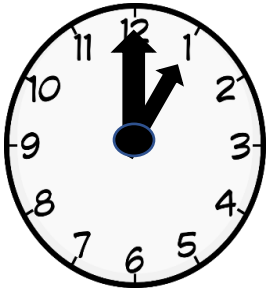

A suffix is a letter or group of letters added at the end of a word which makes a new word.

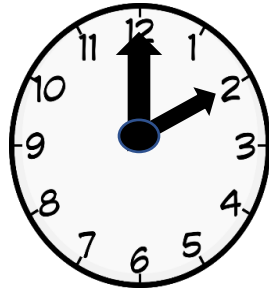
Make new words by adding the suffix k to the Sḵwxwú7mesh numbers.

Numeral	Suffix	New word	Meaning
á'nus	amats'	a'nusámats'	Two strands {of wool, rope, etc.}
chánat	amats'	chanatámats'	Three strands {of wool, rope, etc.}
xa7útsen	amats'	xa7utsenámats'	Four strands {of wool, rope, etc.}
tsíyichis	amats'	tsiyichisámats'	Five strands {of wool, rope, etc.}

Numeral	Suffix	New word	Meaning
á'nus	awanexw	a'nusáwanexw	Two years
chánat	awanexw	chanatáwanexw	Three years
tsíyichis	awanexw	tsiyichisáwanexw	Five years
